

## Health Sciences Application Checklist

### Application Requirements

MCHP's Health Science program provides students an opportunity, not only to complete an Associate's degree, but to prepare for a future course of study within healthcare and enhance their understanding of healthcare. The program requires the completion of 61 credits and may be completed full or part-time. A complete list of courses being offered in fall 2018 may be found on the second page.

Applicants for the Health Science program must meet the following requirements by published admissions deadlines. Please review all requirements carefully.

- Application Fee \$50.00- non-refundable
- Official high school transcript(s) or GED/HiSET sent directly to MCHP from school(s). (Home school students should contact the admissions office.)
- Official college transcript(s), if applicable, sent directly to MCHP from school(s)
- \*Biology with a grade of "C" or higher- high school, college or adult education
- \*Chemistry with a grade of "C" or higher- high school, college or adult education
- \*\*Accuplacer Entrance Exam scores- Reading, Writing, Math and Algebra
- Application Deadline is August 15<sup>th</sup> at 5pm. All application materials must be received by the required deadline. Late materials will not be accepted and incomplete applications will not be considered.

\*A&P I with lab and a grade of "C" or higher may satisfy the Biology requirement and A&P II with lab and a grade of "C" or higher may satisfy the Chemistry requirement.

\*\*The Reading and Writing exams may be waived by successful completion of a college level College Writing course with a grade of "C" or higher. The Math and Algebra exams may be waived by successful completion of a college level College Algebra course with a grade of "C" or higher. Official college transcripts must be provided for exam waiver consideration.
